



Parenteral Drug Association New England Chapter Student Chapter Transfer Scholarship Application for Calendar Year 2022

In 2022, the New England Chapter of the Parenteral Drug Association will award a member of the NEPDA Student Chapter a scholarship of \$5,000 towards completing their first year as transfer student at a four-year college or university.

The Student Chapter Transfer Scholarship was started in 2009 to award a promising NEPDA Student Chapter member for academic achievement and activity promoting and strengthening PDA and the NEPDA Student Chapter.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be active members of the Parenteral Drug Association in two different academic years (one academic year if a transfer student into MCC), have successfully completed the biotech course of study at MCC, and have been accepted to an ABET-accredited baccalaureate program with a life sciences or engineering major. Selection is based on scholastic excellence and participation in chapter activities.

Minimum Acceptance Criteria:

- a. Overall GPA of ≥ 3.00 (B) with a Technical GPA of ≥ 3.50 (B+/A-).
Technical GPA includes math, science, engineering, and technology courses.
- b. Three e-mailed letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from Mariluci Bladon, Paul Patev, Patricia Richard, or Sunny Nguyen.
 - b. One from a different instructor (science or non-science, not the 4 listed above)
 - c. One from Student Chapter President or President-Elect indicating good standing and participation status in chapter activities.
- c. PDA student chapter member in two different academic years (one year if a transfer student into MCC).
- d. Active participation in PDA activities including, but not limited to: Service as Student Chapter officer; attendance at Student Chapter meetings; attendance at NEPDA events such as business meetings, dinner meetings, webinars, or social events; presentation of posters at NEPDA events; other contributions to strengthen the MCC Student Chapter program.
- e. Accepted as at least a half-time student with a life sciences or engineering major at an ABET-accredited four-year college or university.

APPLICATION:

Applicants must submit a completed electronic application, including forms and all supporting materials by Friday May 6, 2022 to: scholarship2022@ne-pda.org

ALL PORTIONS OF THE APPLICATION MUST BE E-MAILED ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE FOR AN APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A SCHOLARSHIP.

Applicants must provide the following:

- ✓ Completed application.
- ✓ An official electronic transcript from MCC.
- ✓ E-mailed letter of recommendation from Mariluci Bladon, Paul Patev, Patricia Richard, or Sunny Nguyen.
- ✓ E-mailed letter of recommendation from one other member of the MCC faculty.
- ✓ E-mailed letter of recommendation from the PDA MCC Student Chapter President or President-Elect indicating good standing and participation status.
- ✓ Acceptance letter to four-year institution.

NOTIFICATION:

- Applicants will receive acknowledgement for receipt of a complete application.
- Applicants will receive notification about the status (decision) regarding their application by July 29, 2022.
- Scholarships will be paid by the NEPDA Treasurer directly to the Bursar of the college or university with instructions to pay 50% in each of two installments corresponding to the start of the semester or at the beginning of the first and third quarters, as applicable.
- Scholarship funds may be used for any expense paid by the recipient directly to the Bursar of the institution.

NEPDA Policies Related to Scholarships

Scholarship Eligibility: Applicants must be active members of the Parenteral Drug Association in two different academic years (one year if a transfer student into MCC) and have completed their course of study at MCC. Selection is based on scholastic excellence and participation in chapter activities.

Scholarship Recipient - Chapter Participation: Scholarship recipients are expected to remain active within the PDA New England Chapter and / or the MCC Student Chapter throughout their Junior and Senior years as a transfer student.

Scholarship Recipient Re-Application: A scholarship recipient who does not attend school during the scholarship term, and thus forfeits the scholarship, is eligible to re-apply and to be considered for a scholarship the next academic year.
